editorial

Hello again, dear reader,

Summer is over and the Passion Play in Oberammergau, Bavaria, Germany, as well.

I missed it, or rather I did not go. (My sister did). I initially wanted to go, as it is performed only every ten years. But what put me really off was the news that they had major changes in the script. I read it in a French paper first, and others reported it as well. The essence: due to pressure from Jewish circles the text had to be purged from "Anti-Semitic passages". The lobbying had started decades ago. So the producer had to avoid passages taken from the Gospel of John (too 'painful' for Jews) and rather stay with Marc.

Among others the phrase spoken to Pilate by the High Priest "Let his blood be on us and on our children!" (Mt 27:25) had to be taken out. Moreover it was not the Jews but the Romans who wanted the elimination of Jesus Christ. This allegedly was discovered by "researchers". Who these are was not said.

Those who have read the Bible and you readers of the New Revelation know that

not "the Jews" were responsible for the crucifixion but the temple and its priests and Pharisees. And there not all of them. The Jewish people were so fond of Jesus that they even wanted Him to be their king. So there is nothing anti-Semitic in the Gospels but truly anti-temple. Just read the Great Gospel of John for back-up.

The Germans of course don't dare to stand up to this kind of pressure due to the Shoah. And so the producer, all the actors and the town representatives gave in, although all were born after 1945. What's also disturbing is what one can do with Christians. Even with the consent of the local Bishop! Can you imagine something like this would be done with the Koran?

Anti-Semitism is something which has to be fought. Join us in fighting it with your knowledge of His Word. But the pressure with which the institutions came up in this case is rather promoting Anti-Semitism.

Coming back to our issue, this time you will find an opinion on the subject of the more or less Christian churches of the world. With the explosion of the Reformation especially there are dozens if not hundreds of them. And all have different definitions of the important issues. Here, Jesus tells us what He thinks about them.

Enjoy this and the other pieces which all have profound spiritual content worth meditating.

1 - fundamentals

You are Peter the Rock

Right after the Wedding of Cana, Jesus travels to the town of Sychar in Samaria where He meets the woman at the well of Jacob. There it is the first time that He openly tells somebody that He is the Messiah. (John 4, 26). Jesus stays in Sychar for a couple of days and then goes to the mountain to deliver His famous sermon.

After the sermon some people together with the high priest criticize Jesus saying that the content of the sermon is too harsh and unrealistic:

"There is hardly a tenable argument against such precepts, but they are too severe and hardly anyone will be able to practice them.

"Who can love his enemy, who do good to the one who harms him maliciously and who can bless those who hate him and speak only bad about him? And if a person wants to borrow something from me, I must not turn away and refuse to listen to him or steel my heart against his words, even if I see clearly that the borrower will never be able to return what he has borrowed? Ah, what a silly thing. If the lazy ones and the shirkers hear about it, will they not promptly go to the wealthy and borrow from them as long as they possess something? Once they have in this way – and nothing is easier than that – lent everything to the poor, who can never return what they have borrowed, and in the end have nothing left themselves, the question arises: who will in the future be working and from whom will the poor then receive a loan? (GGJ01.40)

If God sends or awakes a prophet somewhere, then everyone should crowd around him and listen to him speak the word of God for his greatest well-being; for God awakens such men only once about hundred years in the great depth of the true wisdom of heaven.

But very great prophets, through whom God informs the people of the Earth of very many and great things, are sent to the people of this Earth every thousand to two thousand years at most, on the one hand in order to show them in the greatest and most elaborated ways the further new paths of God towards even higher perfection, and on the other hand to turn them away from the many false paths that they have made themselves and to turn them back onto the one right path.

Jesus knows of course that these priests have an open mind and will accept an explanation. So He advises the high priest to turn to His disciples for interpretation. (GGJ.01.42)

"Here **the High Priest** turns to Nathanael and says to him: 'Following your Master's direction, I now happen to turn to you. Will you, therefore, explain to me at least the most difficult point of the teaching of your master? But please do use only clear and pure words, for with a haze over a haze, a room cannot be illuminated. And now do speak.'

[2] Replies **Nathanael**: 'Are you of such a closed mind that you cannot grasp a clearly
